

2012 Cornhuskin' Rain Plan

The following information is the Rain Plan that will be put into effect if necessary for Cornhuskin'. The date for Cornhuskin' is Friday, November 2, 2012. If Cornhuskin' is canceled on November 2nd, the event will be moved to the rain date of Sunday, November 4th. In the event that the first rain date of November 4th is also canceled due to weather, then the event will be moved to the second rain date of Friday, November 9th.

Times for the events are as follows:

3:30 pm Parade

4:15 pm Picnic

6:00 pm Cornhuskin'—Procession into the Amphitheater begins

If there is cause for concern regarding weather conditions, the decision to reschedule Cornhuskin' will be made as late as possible in the day. Cornhuskin' will be held in all attempts unless there are severe weather conditions (lightning, excessive wind, etc.).

If there are severe weather conditions at 3:30pm (parade time), we will delay the parade beginning time until the weather passes over. Depending on how much time has passed, we will try to follow the Cornhuskin' schedule times as precisely as possible.

If severe weather conditions were to occur after 6:00pm (start of Cornhuskin' competition), we would wait to see if the weather passes over. If the weather passes, we will continue with all events that evening. If the weather is too severe to continue, then the remaining events will be held on the first rain date.

We will always plan to delay the beginning of any event to see if the weather passes. Once the weather passes, the events resume. The only time we would reschedule the entire Cornhuskin' to one of the rain dates would be under the following conditions:

1. There is a perceived danger for students to continue
2. The weather is too persistent and there will be no chance of clearing that night

Rain delay locations to be used for shelter by students and other people involved in Cornhuskin' will be Johnson Hall (Seniors and Sophomores), and Belk Dining Hall (Juniors and Freshman).

**If Cornhuskin' is canceled on Friday, November 2nd, we will evaluate whether or not the picnic and CAB Cornhuskin' after party will still be held and communicate that information to the Meredith community.

The Meredith Recreation Association will take the appropriate action and make the necessary announcements to notify the Meredith community in accordance with the Vice President for College Programs and the Office of Student Leadership and Service regarding the rain plans.
